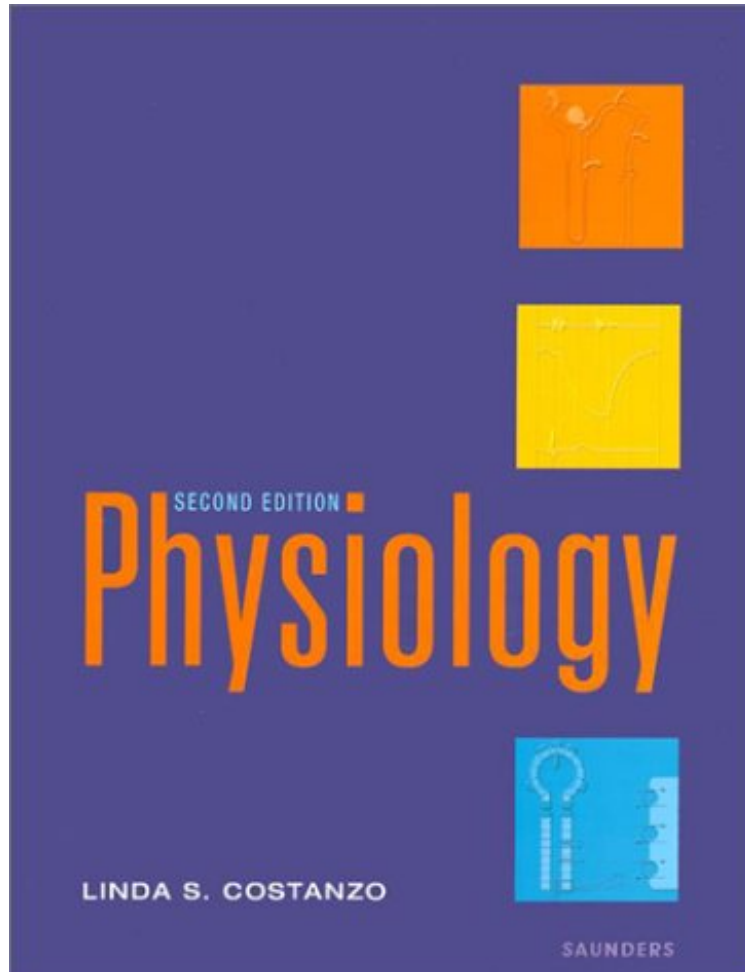

GreeneThis is a great companion to physiology class because you can often use this as your only source of reading and be okay if you also go to class, and the writing is very clear in most cases (there are some areas that could use more/better explanation, but not enough to warrant a deduction in the almighty star rating). Since most people get a review book to accompany the required text, I recommend this one over BRS Physiology (Board Review Series) by the same author because in a time crunch you can read this book only and comprehend the most important points of physiology, even if you don't go to class. No. But, it isn't billed as such. It's more of a review book than anything else...and it's a fine one at that.
