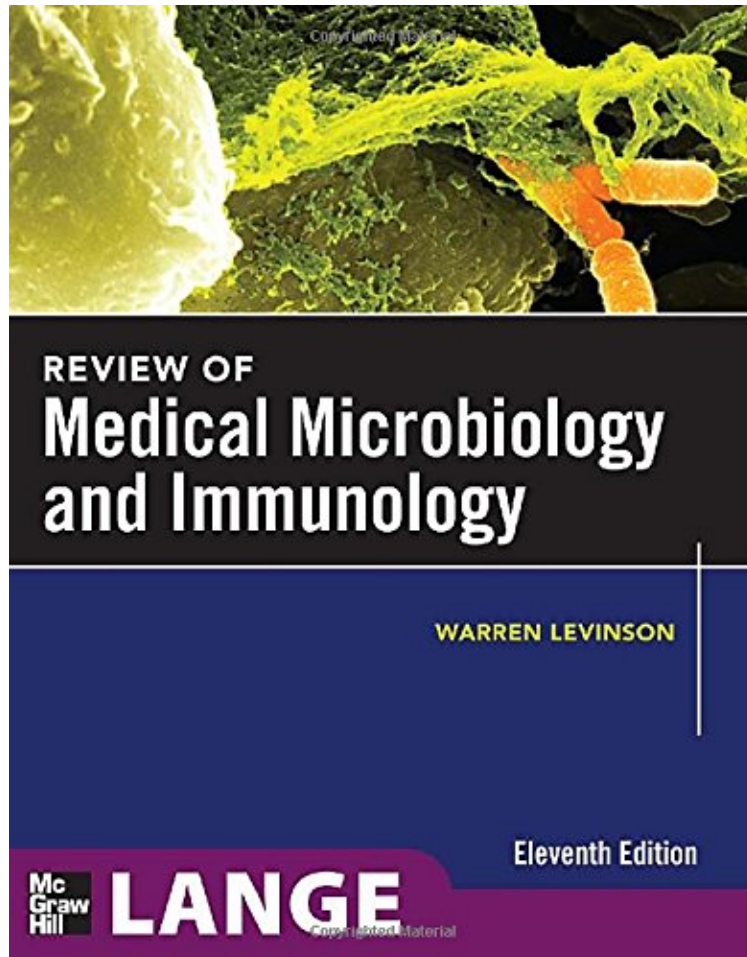

Fantastic review of micro and immunology By learner This is one of the few books I feel compelled to write a review about -- it is incredibly well-written with a narrative that aids in both understanding of the material and memorization of it for the boards. The writing is clear, accessible, and concise -- although there certainly is a bit of repetition of important concepts (which I personally find very helpful). One interesting aspect of this text is its linkage of boards material with current understanding of microbes and other current events. Discussion of recent outbreaks/epidemics, for example, made reading this text much more lively and

explanations of difficult concepts are elucidated incredibly well. Hundreds of step 1-type questions follow at the end (multiple choice), as well as about 40 or so cases using buzz-words that are essential for boards (e.g. currant jelly, flask-like lesion, a rose-gardener with subcutaneous lesions, etc.).
