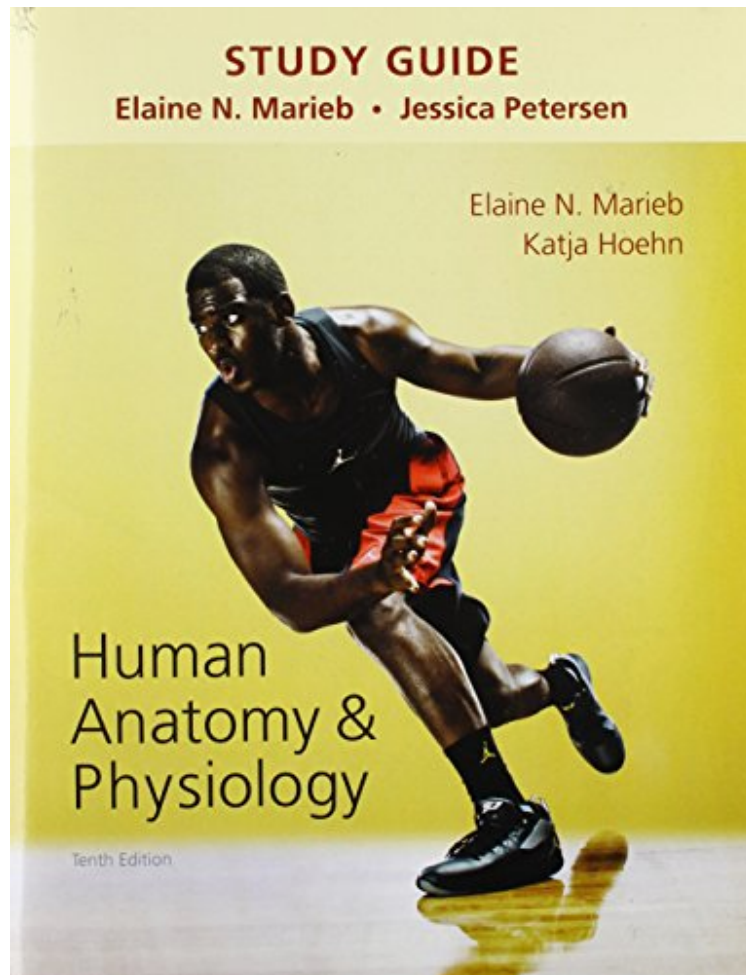

In addition, it is NOT a study guide- it is more of a workbook with certain "exercises" to go along with each chapter. I primarily bought this book thinking that it would have a lot of practice questions, but to my surprise, it hardly has any! And the ones they do have are "choose all of the following that are correct" (a good thinking exercise, but not good for students looking to practice

while studying for their test. I was very disappointed in this book, as it is the official companion to the Marieb textbook that we use in class, and thought it would provide helpful study questions that correspond nicely with each chapter. Instead, it is an 880 page (and softcover so it is heavy and flops around) book with approximately 10-20 pages devoted to each chapter (which I also did not like as I am in AP 2, and those chapters deserve much more space, as they are more difficult topics). HIGHLY overpriced for what you get- and it is also not portable or convenient to take with you to study. This product needs to be re-designed and the content needs to be revised to meet the needs of students. It really should be split into two books- one for AP1 and one for AP2, making it more portable, and also so that the authors can add more (especially practice multiple choice like we would see on our test) to each chapter. 2 of 2 people found the following review helpful.
