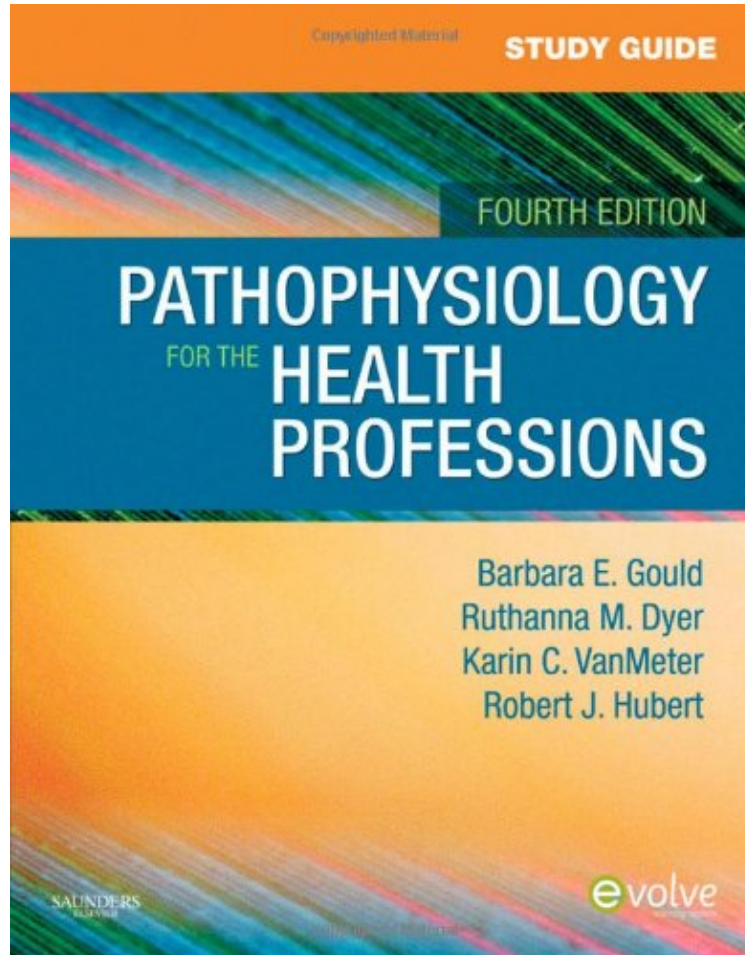

But there are several questions that I feel are far too open-ended like: "Describe eosinophils and their effect on human Pathophysiology." If you have time to study and
