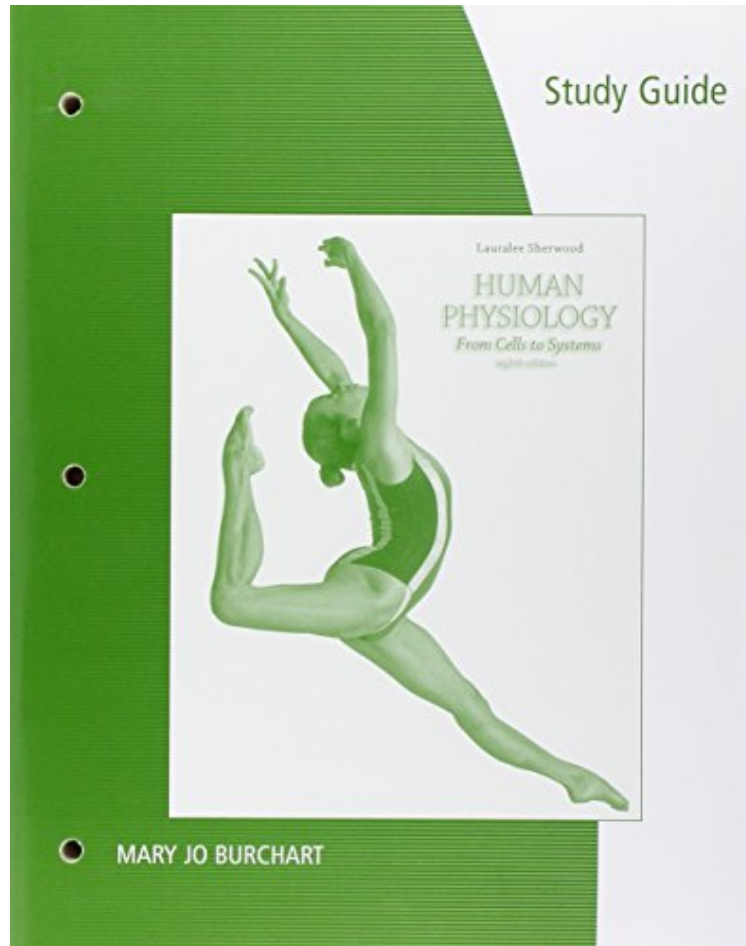

Markovich I found that the bullet points in the "outline" were all of the headers in the textbook (the headers were very helpful, but you only need them once), and the questions were far more specific than anything I would need in my entry level physiology class.
