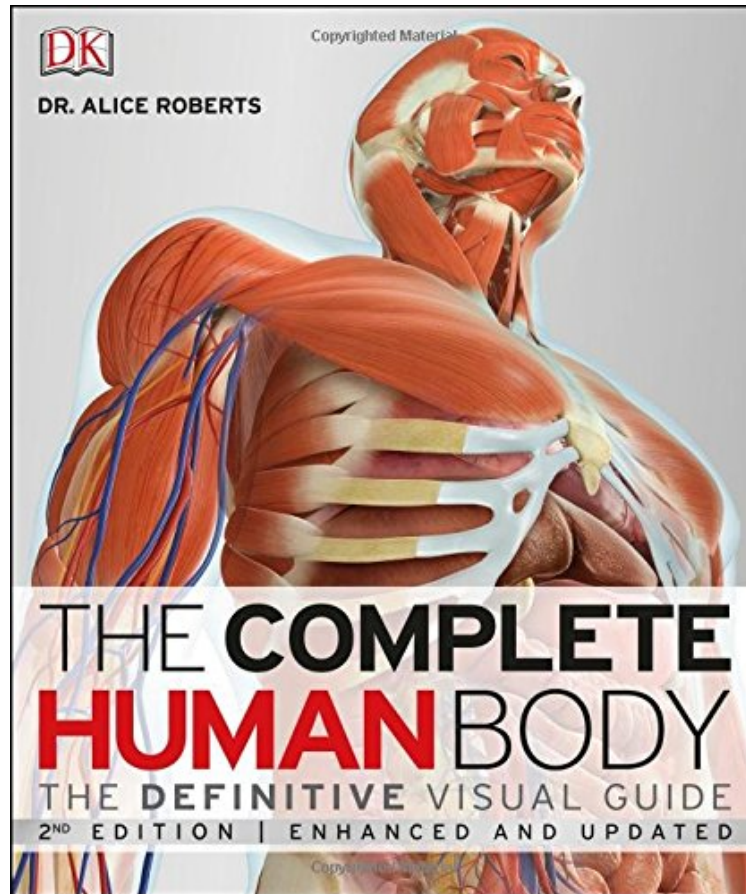

It then moves on to systems, devoting most of its pages to an atlas of human anatomy. Starting from the head and neck and ending at the lower leg and foot, this section illustrates seven regions of the body, primarily employing computer-generated illustrations, but also incorporating cutaway diagrams and clear photos and microscopic and x-ray images. For each designated section of the body, double-page renderings of the skeletal, muscular, nervous, cardiovascular, and lymphatic and immune systems are presented, each clearly introduced and extensively labeled. The extraordinary detail of these pictures will give students an excellent understanding of the body's structure and organization, depicting, layer by layer, the organs that are normally packed closely together and nestled into cavities, with nerves and vessels twisting around.... Other sections focus on How the Body Works, Life Cycle, and Diseases and Disorders, offering the same graphic detail. There's more text in these chapters, which devote two pages each to a multitude of topics (Nerve Cells, Taste and Smell, Blood Cells); the images are smaller, but well chosen and more numerous. While not all libraries may need such extensive mapping of the human body Steve Parker's *The Human Body* (DK, 2007) may suffice for many there is nothing that rivals Roberts's singular volume.
