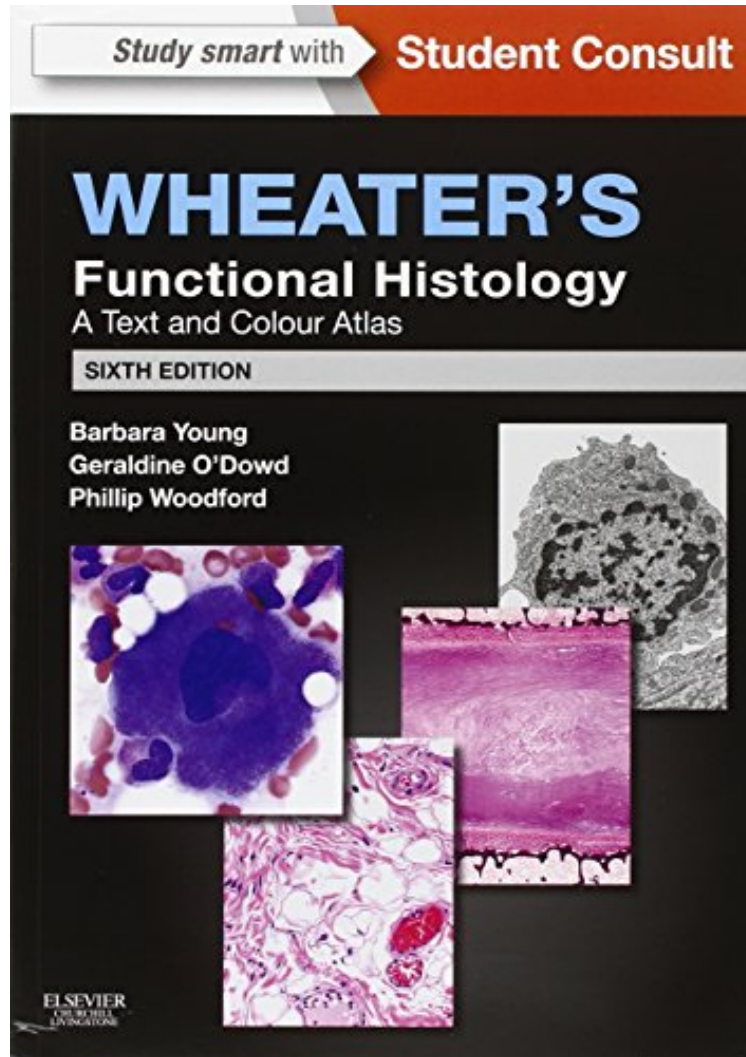

The book is in 3 parts, Part I, The Cell, Part II, Basic Tissue Types, and Part III, Organ Systems. Each of these parts are then broken down into subdivisions with their own chapters (Cell = cell structure and function, cell cycle and replication) (Tissue = blood, connective, epithelial, muscle, nervous) (Organ = circulatory, skin, skeletal, immune, respiratory, oral, gastrointestinal, liver and pancreas, urinary, endocrine, male reproductive, female reproductive, central nervous, special sense). The text is easy to follow and there are plenty of pictures throughout. I found this to be a necessary companion to my Carson and Hladik textbook because there were more specific examples of tissues in this book.
